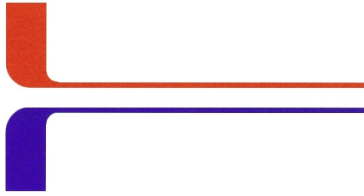

SUBJECT: 2014 National Fineleaf Fescue Test
TO: Seed Companies and Breeders
FROM: Kevin N. Morris, Executive Director
DATE: June 23, 2014

Plans have been finalized for the upcoming national fineleaf fescue test sponsored by the National Turfgrass Evaluation Program (NTEP).

The following gives the details concerning this test. Please complete the enclosed Test Entry Application Form and Sponsorship Agreement for each entry you wish to submit. The first payment for testing is due when the seed is shipped to us. Please make checks payable to the "National Turfgrass Evaluation Program" in \$US only.

PLEASE NOTE: Several significant changes have been made to this trial so please read carefully:

- 1. We have changed the entry fee structure for this trial. Experimental entries will be charged a reduced entry fee (\$1,000/year), which will remain at that level until the entry is named or commercialized (please see details below). Also, entries that have been previously tested by NTEP can be entered at a reduced entry fee (\$1,500/year).**
- 2. This trial will run for five years, therefore, five entry fee payments are required. The overall entry fee is \$10,000 for a commercially available entry.**
- 3. More ancillary trial locations (11) will be established than in past trials, covering more traits. Traffic under fairway height (four locations), traffic under lawn height (three locations), a fairway mowing height site in the lower North Central region, two shade locations and a one mow per season site are the ancillary traits to be evaluated. Ten (10) standard trial locations will also be established.**
- 4. Our deadline for receipt of seed is August 18th.**

The list of the chosen trial locations and details on the ancillary trial parameters, as well as these forms, are posted in the NTEP News Room (www.ntep.org/newsroom.htm.)

Standard test locations will be maintained using management parameters that are appropriate for each region and will be established by each cooperator. Plot size will be 25 sq. ft. (5' x 5', 4' x 6' or similar size) replicated three times and the seeding rate will be 50 grams per plot (4.4 lbs./1000 sq. ft.). Therefore, we will need 8 lbs. (1 kg) of seed of each entry.

2014 NATIONAL FINELEAF FESCUE TEST (page two)

There are now three categories of entries. The following is an explanation of the new entry fee structure:

Commercial entries (named, commercially produced and/or marketed):

\$2,000.00 each entry - when seed is sent to us
\$2,000.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2015
\$2,000.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2016
\$2,000.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2017
\$2,000.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2018

\$10,000.00 total

Previously tested entries (have been included in previous NTEP tests):

\$1,500.00 each entry - when seed is sent to us
\$1,500.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2015
\$1,500.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2016
\$1,500.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2017
\$1,500.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2018

\$7,500.00 total

Experimental entries* (have never been named, commercially produced and/or marketed):

\$1,000.00 each entry - when seed is sent to us
\$1,000.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2015
\$1,000.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2016
\$1,000.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2017
\$1,000.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2018

\$5,000.00 total

*** If an *Experimental* entry is named, commercially produced or marketed during the testing period, NTEP will be notified within 30 days by the entry sponsor. At that time, the entry will be reclassified as a *Commercial* entry and the fee will become \$10,000 total for the trial. NTEP will immediately invoice the sponsor or licensee for any past entry fees. Current and future NTEP entry fees will be invoiced at \$2,000 per year. This will expire the date of the last trial data publication.**

2014 NATIONAL FINELEAF FESCUE TEST (page three)

The following are guidelines for sending seed for this test:

- a. **8 lbs.** of seed of each entry must be received at Beltsville, MD by August 18th, 2014.
- b. Seed received after August 18th, 2014 but by August 22th, 2014 can be included in this test but a **double (2x)** entry fee will be charged.
- c. Seed received after August 22th, 2014 will **not** be included in this test.
- d. The entire requested amount of seed is needed for an entry to be included in this test. Entries that are received with less than the requested amount of seed will **not** be included in this test.

We encourage good planning in preparing and shipping entries on or before the August 18th deadline. In addition, it would be helpful to send seed earlier than the August 18th deadline if possible. Please do not send seed treated with a pesticide. Treated seed will **not** be accepted by the NTEP. Also, please make sure seed is prepaid for shipping charges to Beltsville, MD. The NTEP will **not** pay any additional shipping fees to forward seed to Beltsville.
