



SUBJECT: 2022 National Perennial Ryegrass Test

TO: Seed Companies and Breeders

Plans have been finalized for the upcoming national perennial ryegrass test sponsored by the National Turfgrass Evaluation Program (NTEP).

The following gives the details concerning this test. Please complete the enclosed Test Entry Application Form and Sponsorship Agreement for each entry you wish to submit. The first payment for testing is due when the seed is shipped to us. Please make checks payable to the "National Turfgrass Evaluation Program" in \$US only.

**Following is important information for this trial:**

- 1. The NTEP Policy Committee recently passed an entry fee increase. This increase, the first in over 20 years, will help to pay for improvements to the database and user interface. Version 1.0 of the database will be publicly available for the first time in mid-summer 2022.**
- 2. The entry fee schedule for this trial is as follows: *Experimental* entries will be charged a reduced entry fee (\$1,200/year or \$6,000 total), which will remain at that level until the entry is named or commercialized (please see details below). *Previously tested* entries can be entered at a reduced entry fee of \$1,700/year, or \$8,500 total. *Commercially available* entries will be \$2,200 per year, or \$11,000 total.**
- 3. This trial will run for five years, therefore, five entry fee payments are required.**
- 4. Ten (10) ancillary trial locations will be established including: Shade tolerance, traffic tolerance, fairway mowing, salt tolerance and overseeding.**
- 5. Eleven (11) standard trial locations will also be established.**
- 6. Our deadline for receipt of seed is August 22th.**

For a list of the chosen trial locations and details on the ancillary trial parameters, please see the attached document. This information is also available on our website, [www.ntep.org/newsroom.htm](http://www.ntep.org/newsroom.htm).

Standard test locations will be maintained within one of three maintenance regimes: fairway, athletic field or home lawn. Plot size will be 25 sq. ft. (5' x 5', 4' x 6' or similar size) replicated three times and the seeding rate will be 68 grams per plot (6 lbs./1000 sq. ft.). Therefore, we will need **14 lbs.** (6.35 kg) of seed of each entry.

## 2022 National Perennial Ryegrass Test (page two)

There are three categories of entries. The following is an explanation of the entry fee structure:

**Commercial entries (named, commercially produced and/or marketed in the U.S. or anywhere in the world):**

\$2,200.00 each entry - when seed is sent to us  
\$2,200.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2023  
\$2,200.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2024  
\$2,200.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2025  
\$2,200.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2026

**Previously tested entries (have been included in previous NTEP tests):**

\$1,700.00 each entry - when seed is sent to us  
\$1,700.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2023

\$1,700.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2025  
\$1,700.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2026

\$8,500.00 total

**Experimental entries\* (have never been named, commercially produced and/or marketed in the U.S. or anywhere in the world):**

\$1,200.00 each entry - when seed is sent to us  
\$1,200.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2023  
\$1,200.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2024  
\$1,200.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2025  
\$1,200.00 each entry - on or before June 1, 2026

\$6,000.00 total

**\* If an *Experimental* entry is named, commercially produced or marketed in the U.S. or anywhere in the world during the testing period, NTEP will be notified within 30 days by the entry sponsor. At that time, the entry will be reclassified as a *Commercial* entry and the fee will become \$11,000 total for the trial. NTEP will immediately invoice the sponsor or licensee for any past entry fees. Current and future NTEP entry fees will be invoiced at \$2,200 per year. This will expire the date of the last trial data publication.**

The following are guidelines for sending seed for this test:

- a. **14 lbs.** of seed of each entry must be received at Beltsville, MD by August 22, 2022.
- b. Seed received after August 22, 2022 but by August 26, 2022 can be included in this test, but a **double (2x)** entry fee will be charged.
- c. Seed received after August 26, 2022 will **not** be included in this test.
- d. The entire requested amount of seed is needed for an entry to be included in this test. Entries that are received with less than the requested amount of seed will **not** be included in this test.

**2022 National Perennial Ryegrass Test (page three)**

We encourage good planning in preparing and shipping entries on or before the August 22th deadline. In addition, it would be helpful to send seed earlier than the August 22th deadline if possible. Please do not send seed treated with a pesticide. Treated seed will **not** be accepted by the NTEP. Also, please make sure seed is prepaid for shipping charges to Beltsville, MD. The NTEP will **not** pay any additional shipping fees to forward seed to Beltsville.

NTEP will immediately invoice the sponsor or licensee for any past entry fees. Current and future NTEP entry fees will be invoiced at \$2,200 per year. This will expire the date of the last trial data publication.
